Aim

To give participants an educational and experiential training around the key elements of Rites of Passage (ROP) that will allow participants to design or participate as leaders in ROP camps for teenage boys (can change gender but do so with care)

Methodology

- Providing information, outline and explore the three stages of a rites of passage and provide a contemporary context and how these are integrated in the Rites Together camps
- Experiential processes, where participants can experience the camp processes to gain insights and knowledge about how the processes may impact on the camp attendees and how this may influence how camp processes are variable and flexible whilst on camp
- Sharing/feedback, for participants to provide their unique perspectives on the training and camp activities and to see how these can be adapted and used in different contexts. It also allows participant leaders to provide their insights, wisdom and perspective to improve and continuously evolve our camps

Who is this for?

- Those with life experience wanting to mentor and support others and give back into the community by supporting Community and family based Rites of passage
- Younger men and women passionate about rites of passage and interested in spreading the programs in WA
- Leaders already working in the youth field and wanting to embrace a rites of passage element into their work
- Past participants in Rites of passage camps that want to become leaders or support the camps in future Anyone who wants to explore their leadership style in an open honest, challenging and participating environment. (no PowerPoint presentations)





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By the end you will have:

- Understand the key elements of ROP
- Awareness of how the elements of ROP work together
- Experience of key elements of a ROP
- Exploration of leadership in ROP
- Opportunity to practice leadership
- Awareness of family dynamics and generational traits
- Opportunity for self-reflection and awareness and how we show up, what gifts we bring and what may get in the way of being the best leaders we can be
- Networking with other participants with interests in ROP
- An ongoing leader pathway
